

DOMINION THROUGH THE MOUTH

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Dominion has to do with ruling, control and authority. To have dominion is to exercise authority over the affairs of life, circumstances, and satanic powers to create the right and desired experience in life.

RIGHT TO DOMINION

To understand this subject it is important that we start from the book of beginning to see what God had in mind when He created man, then we will come to what Jesus did and how it affected us. I don't want you walking around like a slave; I don't want you walking around as someone who doesn't know who he is in Christ. You must walk around with the mentality of a king because that is what you are. In fact, Jesus said "*Ye are gods*" (*Jn 10:34*).

1. Man was created for dominion

Gen 1:26-28

26 Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth." 27 So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. 28 Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

Why did God create man? So that man will rule, and have dominion over all that God has created on the earth - the fish of the sea, the animals on the ground, the livestock and over everything that creeps upon the earth. In other words we were created basically to take charge on earth; we were created to administer God's estate. I want you to understand this, so that you can understand what Jesus meant when he said "*occupy till I come*". When God created man, He created man with this intention in mind that we may represent Him, rule over all that He has created, be managers, stewards, and govern all His creation. If someone opened a company and asked you to manage the company for him, it means that you are in charge of it, and you will also stand between him and the people that work under you in that company. It means you will give account to him. It also means you will determine what happens in that company, because you have been given the power of attorney to manage it. You will tell him what your plans are and the things you need and he will give his approval and let you do your job. It is what you tell him, that he will listen to. You need to understand that when God created man, this was His intention, not that man should be a slave, or should be ruled over by all He has created, but, to rule over them.

2. The believer was redeemed to have dominion

In Christ through redemption, the believer received authority to dominate his world decides what happens.

Rom 5:17

17 For if, by the trespass of the one man, death reigned through that one man, how much more will those who receive God's abundant provision of grace and of the gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man, Jesus Christ.

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FOUR WARNINGS

- a.** Guard your tongue that you may preserve your life.

Prov 13:3

3 He who guards his lips guards his life, but he who speaks rashly will come to ruin.

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- b.** Guard your tongue lest you wound and hurt another and in the end make enemies.

Prov 12:18-19

18 Reckless words pierce like a sword, but the tongue of the wise brings healing. 19 Truthful lips endure forever, but a lying tongue lasts only a moment.

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Prov 15:14

14 The discerning heart seeks knowledge, but the mouth of a fool feeds on folly.

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Prov 25:23

23 As a north wind brings rain, so a sly tongue brings angry looks.

d. Guard your tongue that you may not be ensnared by the words of your lips.

Num 14:26-35

26 The LORD said to Moses and Aaron: 27 "How long this will wicked community grumble against me? I have heard the complaints of these grumbling Israelites. 28 So tell them, 'As surely as I live, declares the LORD, I will do to you the very things I heard you say: 29 In this desert your bodies will fall--every one of you twenty years old or more who was counted in the census and who has grumbled against me. 30 Not one of you will enter the land I swore with uplifted hand to make your home, except Caleb son of Jephunneh and Joshua son of Nun. 31 As for your children that you said would be taken as plunder, I will bring them in to enjoy the land you have rejected. 32 But you--your bodies will fall in this desert. 33 Your children will be shepherds here for forty years, suffering for your unfaithfulness, until the last of your bodies lies in the desert. 34 For forty years--one year for each of the forty days you explored the land--you will suffer for your sins and know what it is like to have me against you.' 35 I, the LORD, have spoken, and I will surely do these things to this whole wicked community, which has banded together against me. They will meet their end in this desert; here they will die."

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Prov 6:1-5

My son, if you have put up security for your neighbor, if you have struck hands in pledge for another, 2 if you have been trapped by what you said, ensnared by the words of your mouth, 3 then do this, my son, to free yourself, since you have fallen into your neighbor's hands: Go and humble yourself; press your plea with your neighbor! 4 Allow no sleep to your eyes, no slumber to your eyelids. 5 Free yourself, like a gazelle from the hand of the hunter, like a bird from the snare of the fowler.
