Luke 1:30-33

These passages make it very clear that Jesus loves mankind enough to sacrifice his life for all. Such a man can take care of me. The pain and torture he went through was because he loved man. And he still loves man. He loves you. He has done willingly what you cannot do. He laid down his life freely and willingly that you be saved delivered and restored back to God. He died that you may not

be punished for your sins if you will repent and believe in his name. He died and rose that you may have access to the presence of God. He died and rose that you may be delivered from the oppressive power of the devil, and be made a king and priest of God to reign in this life over all the powers of the enemy and his works. He laid down his life because of love. That love is still there. He still cares.

You may still be in sin, or be living a hypocritical life, but I want you to know he still loves you. Though he hates your life of sin and pretence, he still loves you. His love is new every day. He is the same yesterday, today and forever. He will help and take care of you.

John 1:1-5

There is no one in the universe greater than him. Unto him shall every knee bow. At the mention of his name, every knee in heaven and on earth bows, and every tongue confesses that he is Lord. When he works, no one can hinder. As he has planned, so it will be. As he has purposed, so it shall stand. No one can thwart his purposes. And no one can turn his hand backward when he stretches it forward to carry out his purposes. He is the ruler of the universe. The Bible calls him the "*Head of all principalities*". John 10:11-14

Then the wolf attacks the flock and scatters it. 13 The man runs away because he is a hired hand and cares nothing for the sheep. 14 "I am the good shepherd; I know my sheep and my sheep know me-

The LORD is my shepherd, I shall not be in want. 2 He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters, 3 he restores my soul. He guides me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake. 4 Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. 5 You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. 6 Surely goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever.
