1. Godly men don't demand to touch, taste and to test before marriage.
 - Treat your friend as God's temple that must not be defiled or destroyed.
 - If you know that there are some environments you can't control yourself, stay away.
 - Wise men are also careful in the use of the phrase "I love you". Love for a woman is a wholesome thing, for a man, it is just a sweet word that must be spoken.

2. Godly men should not date ladies who dress to seduce.

3. Do not reject a man because he does not have a sleek car.
 - That he does not have a car or the car of your choice does not make him a bad guy.

4. No matter how attractive he or she may be, make sure you have the same philosophy of faith, e.g. commitment to church activities, tithing, speaking in tongues and soul winning efforts.

5. The person who describes you only by your externals is your biggest cause for alarm.
 - Do not build your relationship on his description of your outer qualities without reference to who you are on the inside.
 - The externals are fleeting and could change.

6. A stingy man who is single will still be a stingy man when married.

7. The person who refuses to change now and puts forth action to a later time will not change when married. He will keep up the same practice until something drastic happens to him.

8. Some men with poor self-esteem are afraid of strong women.
 - Men's fear of a strong woman is centered on the fear of her control.
 - Do not fear women with imposing personality, they don't bite. Some of them are sweet and soft inside. Look beyond the features. God made them for some people - You may be one of them.
 - It is also important for a woman who is an achiever vocationally, educationally and spiritually to also conduct herself in such a way that men will see her as someone who will submit to her husband, when and in an appropriate way.

- 10.** Anyone you are in relationship with or drawing close to you, and is always showing signs of boredom with spiritual things like studying the word of God, Praying, fasting and evangelism either by words or action is not totally converted. You will have problem with such.

- 11.** Anyone who is comfortable and more comfortable in the presence of sinners, those who speak against Ministers of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the work of God, (the rebellious) is not fit for you to marry.

- 12.** No relationship will succeed when only one party is giving and making input for the success of the relationship. It takes two to succeed in a relationship.

- 13.** A man should by nature be a pursuant, a hunter. If you are the one going after him you will fall apart when he withdraws his love.
 - Men and women handle emotional matters differently. Men are quick to fall in love, and most of the time quicker to be out of it.
 - The woman is like a sponge – having absorbed so much water, it takes time to squeeze everything out.
 - Follow the man behind and don't run ahead of the man. Let there be no over-investment of emotions so it will be easier to handle the separation when the man pulls out.

- 14.** Godly wise men and women do not stay in a relationship because they pity their friend.
 - It is unwise to continue a relationship that is obvious would not work out well simply because of the consideration of what the other person may go through if the relationship ends.
 - It is also unwise to go into marriage with someone because the person has suffered in the past and you want to comfort the person.
 - There is a difference between compassion for the hurting and marital love.

- 15.** One reason why relationships end is because women talk down at the men. Do not talk to the man like a boy.
 - Women who have imposing and domineering attitude should train themselves in this area if they wish to be successful in their relationships or marriage.

- You can't command a man the way you command your staff at the office or junior ones at home.
 - Women who have lived with children as single parents for a long period of time need to particularly watch how they talk to their dates. The chances are that you may transfer the way you talk to your children to him.
- 16.** It is a sign of danger when he asks you to wear a "come and get me clothes". Refuse it,
- Dressing does not only cover our nakedness but packages and presents us the way we want to be looked upon. It reveals the kind of person we are on the inside.
- 17.** Men are attracted to strong women who dress decently, not those who wear suggestive clothing.
- There is a company of women who think the first point of call for most men is how 'sexy' they look. Real men want a wife and not a Delilah or a high tension cable.
- 18.** There is a danger if the following signs are present:
- If he does not want to open up about the past.
 - If he has a chronic desire to be in control of everything all the time.
 - If he does not participate in seeking help for himself.
 - If he gives excuses for his behaviour.
 - If he has a lot of guilt, blame and low self-esteem about his past.
 - If he does not want to overcome his addictions.
 - If he plays the blame-game.
 - If his attitude to life is hopelessly negative.
 - If you seem to be doing everything for him.
 - If it seems you are the only one with the drive to make the relationship work.
- 19.** You don't need to sleep with someone to prove you love the person. You just need to let the person know that you love him or her.
