

PROPHETIC PRAYING

Prophetic praying is a powerful form of praying that every believer should practice. It is not a pleading type of praying, but a prophesying. You stand as a son of God and king and exercise the great and ultimate authority of God given to us in Christ Jesus.

A son has right to all his father has – authority, power and all his estate. We are joint heirs with Jesus Christ. Whatever Jesus Christ has access to in God, we have also as sons of God.

John 1:12-13

12 Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God- 13 children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God.

John 3:31

31 "The one who comes from above is above all; the one who is from the earth belongs to the earth, and speaks as one from the earth. The one who comes from heaven is above all.

Gal 3:29

29 If you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

Rom 8:17

17 And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.

You must be solid in faith about this truth to practice prophetic praying. Be grounded on this subject. Go to the word to know all that the scripture says about your son-ship in Christ. It will build strong faith in you and produce the strong confidence you need to prophesy without a single doubt in your heart, for only when you speak without doubt that you have what you say.

In prophetic praying, you address the evil and ugly situation and the powers behind it – you move your mountains. In prophetic praying, you amplify the voice of God with your own voice; you say what you want to see in authority and confidence without a single doubt based on what God has said or is saying.

In-depth knowledge of the word of God is necessary if prophetic praying is to be practiced with success. If you are not full of the word of God, you cannot have enough

faith and confidence to say to situations move without doubts. Much word brings much faith. Less word, brings little faith

The basic foundation of Prophetic praying is Faith in God.

- Faith in the person of God.
- Faith in the love of God.
- Faith in the faithfulness of God.
- Faith in the willingness, readiness and ableness of God to answer your prayers and meet all your needs.
- Faith in the laws of God.
- Faith in the promises of God.
- Faith in the infallibility of God and His word

Mark 11:22-23

22 "Have faith in God," Jesus answered. 23 "I tell you the truth, if anyone says to this mountain, 'Go, throw yourself into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart but believes that what he says will happen, it will be done for him.

NIV

- It is true that you will have what you say if you believe and not doubt.
- God does not lie.
- "Anyone" includes you.
- "Anyone" is one who believes and wants to see what he or she says come to pass.

Matt 12:34-37

34 You brood of vipers, how can you who are evil say anything good? For out of the overflow of the heart the mouth speaks. 35 The good man brings good things out of the good stored up in him, and the evil man brings evil things out of the evil stored up in him. 36 But I tell you that men will have to give account on the day of judgment for every careless word they have spoken. 37 For by your words you will be acquitted, and by your words you will be condemned."

NIV

- You speak out of the overflow of your heart.
- If you have negatives in your mind, you will speak out negatives. If you have positives in your mind, you will speak out positives.
- Worries, anxiety, doubt and fear must not be permitted into your mind or words will be full of negatives.
- Your thoughts give birth to your words.
- Your words will acquit and set you free from all oppression of the enemy.
- Your words will condemn and destroy you and all you stand for or have going for you.
- Your words matter to God such that you will have to give account to God of all that you have spoken.
- Your words determine how God treats you or responds to you.

Eccl 8:4

4 Where the word of a king is, there is power: and who may say unto him, what doest thou?

KJV

- As a king in Christ, your words carry so much authority that the angels of God do not question them but carry them out as long as it does not contradict the word of God.

Prov 18:20-21

20 From the fruit of his mouth a man's stomach is filled; with the harvest from his lips he is satisfied. 21 The tongue has the power of life and death, and those who love it will eat its fruit.

NIV

- Every man will harvest what his mouth has spoken – your words will always come back to you whether you like it, expect it or not.
- Your experience, your future and your life lies in the use of your tongue.
- Understanding of the potency of the tongue helps you to use it to the fullest advantage.

Isa 45:11

11 Thus saith the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, and his Maker, Ask me of things to come concerning my sons, and concerning the work of my hands command ye me.

Ezek 37:1-14

37:1 The hand of the LORD was upon me, and he brought me out by the Spirit of the LORD and set me in the middle of a valley; it was full of bones. 2 He led me back and forth among them, and I saw a great many bones on the floor of the valley, bones that were very dry. 3 He asked me, "Son of man, can these bones live?"

I said, "O Sovereign LORD, you alone know."

4 Then he said to me, "Prophesy to these bones and say to them, 'Dry bones, hear the word of the LORD! 5 This is what the Sovereign LORD says to these bones: I will make breath enter you, and you will come to life. 6 I will attach tendons to you and make flesh come upon you and cover you with skin; I will put breath in you, and you will come to life. Then you will know that I am the LORD.'"

7 So I prophesied as I was commanded. And as I was prophesying, there was a noise, a rattling sound, and the bones came together, bone to bone. 8 I looked, and tendons and flesh appeared on them and skin covered them, but there was no breath in them.

9 Then he said to me, "Prophesy to the breath; prophesy, son of man, and say to it, 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says: Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe into these slain, that they may live.'" 10 So I prophesied as he commanded me, and breath entered them; they came to life and stood up on their feet—a vast army.

11 Then he said to me: "Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel. They say, 'Our bones are dried up and our hope is gone; we are cut off.' 12 Therefore prophesy and say to them: 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says: O my people, I am going to open your graves and bring you up from them; I will bring you back to the land of Israel. 13 Then you, my people, will know that I am the LORD, when I open your graves and bring you up from them. 14 I will put my Spirit in you and you will live, and I will settle you in your own land. Then you will know that I the LORD have spoken, and I have done it, declares the LORD.'"

NIV

- There is no condition that cannot be changed.
- There is miracle power in the tongue of man who believes in God; Jesus Christ is Son and His word.
- All you need to do is prophesy to the situation what God has said in His word or is saying right now to you. Amplify the word of God with your voice and soon, it will come to pass.
- Say what you want to see and not what is and you don't want.
- Use your mouth to change what you don't want.
- You can prophesy more than once to a given situation until things become what you want it to be. Based on the above scriptural example, you keep prophesying as situation changes until things become what you want it to be.
- Prophesy the word of God to the situation you want to change, and God will bring His word to pass.
- Keep prophesying and never doubt and things will change as you have spoken.
- Believe, say it. Keep believing and saying it. Never stop saying it and believing it, and then you will see it.
- Don't cry, don't panic or worry, but speak to the situation.
